- A. Student Research Presentations (8 min max)
- B. Recent/Current/New Research Presentations (8 min max)
- C. Vignettes (2 minute/2 slides max)

All submissions must include:

- 1. Which category you are submitting to
- 2. Title
- 3. Abstract (Informal)
- 4. Contact Information
- 5. Accompanying Powerpoint Slides or Paper

*Please note that the abstract will be used to decide which applications will be chosen for presentation * All presentation applicants must be current members of the AATA.

Please see the following guidelines for submission below:

A. Student Research Presentations Guidelines

1. Student presentations must relate to athletic therapy related research (e.g., injury, injury assessment, injury management, injury prevention, modalities, ethical issues in sport, sport nutrition). In the spirit of diversity, the selection committee may restrict the number of presentations in any one particular field of interest.

2. The presentation must be based on an original term/research paper created by the student.

3. All students will be allotted 8 minutes for their presentation; there is no number limit for slides.

4. 2 minutes will be allocated for questions following each presentation.

5. Humour is allowed, however, the focus of the presentation should remain educational.

6. Both research paper (must be completed in Microsoft Word or equivalent) and presentation slides (must be completed using Microsoft Powerpoint or equivalent) must be submitted to the Research Presentation Chair by the deadline date.

Prize money will be awarded for student research presentations

B. Recent/New/Current Research Presentations Guidelines

1. R/N/C research presentations must relate to athletic therapy related research (e.g., injury, injury assessment, injury management, injury prevention, modalities, ethical issues in sport, sport nutrition).

2. The presentation must be based on an original term/research paper created by the presenter.

3. All presenters will be allotted 8 minutes for their presentation; there is no number limit for slides.

4. 2 minutes will be allocated for questions following each presentation.

5. Humour is allowed; however, the focus of the presentation should remain educational.

6. Both research paper (must be completed in Microsoft Word or equivalent) and presentation slides (must be completed using Microsoft Powerpoint or equivalent) must be submitted to the Research Presentation Chair by the deadline date.

C. Vignette Guidelines

1. Vignettes can relate to athletic therapy related research, unique case presentations, clinical tips, or any research/educational topics/pearls of wisdom that would serve to benefit athletic therapists in the room.

2. Presentations will be limited to TWO minutes and TWO slides maximum.

3. This time limit will be strictly enforced by a referee.

4. All topics and slides (must be completed in Microsoft Powerpoint or equivalent), must be submitted to the Research Presentation Chair by the deadline date.

5. Only 2 questions will be allocated to each presentation.

Non-monetary prizes will be awarded for winners in Categories B & C Preference will be given to Category A applicants. Not all applicants will be selected to present, a maximum of 10 presentations will be chosen. Chosen applicants will be notified by email by April 15, 2023.
